








# WebEOC Quick Start Guide

## Navigating WebEOC

<p>After logging into WebEOC, locate the box shape containing lines and a down arrow, below “Welcome”, on the left side of the Home page.</p> 	
<p>Click on the down arrow. This will open the Control Panel for this position and incident.</p> <p>Here you will locate the list of boards, menus, and plugins accessible by your position. Launch an item by clicking on it.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li> The star indicates there is new data in this board since the last time the board was viewed.</li> <li> The arrow symbol allows you to open a board in a separate window.</li> </ul>	



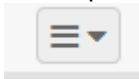

### Navigating WebEOC

Here for example, the Damage Assessment board has been opened. Note that a Tab with “Damage Assessment” opened up on the top bar next to the home image. The tab for the board or option that is currently being viewed is **dark blue**.

Select another board from the Control panel dropdown



A new tab is now open for that board.

You can return to the Damage Assessment board easily by clicking on the “Damage Assessment” tab.

One can toggle between boards by clicking on whatever tab you desire.

The arrows at the far right or left of the row of tabs can then be used to scroll through the entire list of open tabs.






To close a board or option click the **X** in the upper right corner of the tab.

### Navigating WebEOC

<p>Clicking on the down arrow image to the far right of the tabs will show a list to quickly move between tabs.</p>  <p>Clicking on any item returns you to that board, menu item, form, Plugin, or the Home Page. This will be helpful if more tabs are open than can be displayed on the page.</p>	
<p><b>NOTE: The color of the tab is important.</b> The tab for the current view is dark blue. Any tab that is light blue with a star icon on the tab indicates a change to that board that you have not yet viewed.</p>	
<p><b>To change Positions and Incidents,</b> locate the pull downs at the top of the page.</p>	
<p>Select the <b>Position dropdown</b> for the position list and select another position.</p> <p><b>Feature:</b> When you select a new position from the dropdown and open several boards and then decide to select a new position from the dropdown, all the open tabs opened for that position are not lost. When you return to the previous position, all the boards that you had opened are still there and available.</p>

## Navigating WebEOC

Select the **Incident dropdown** for the Incident list and select another incident.
